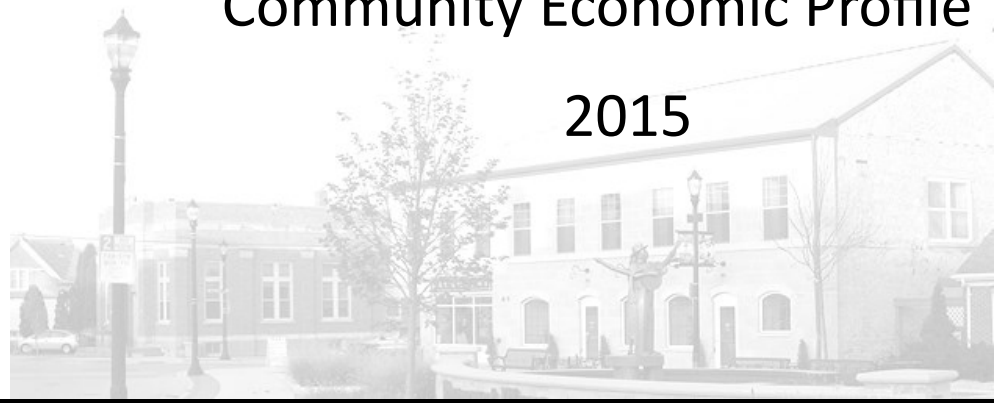

## Amenities

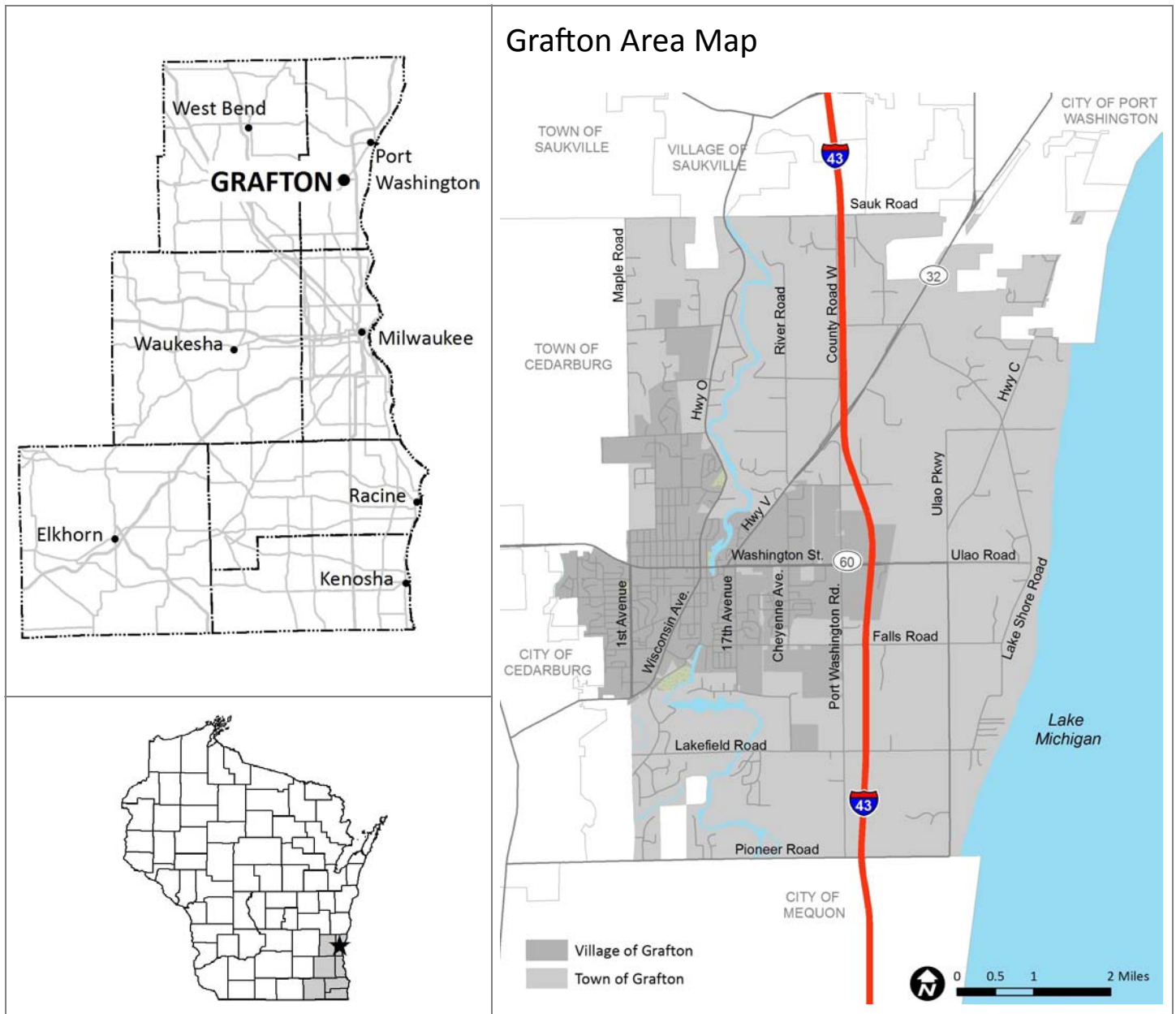
